The Vice-Chancellor extended a warm welcome and thanked the members for sparing their valuable time for attending the meeting.

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The following items were taken up for consideration:-

1. Agenda Item no. 16/1:To confirm the minutes of the last meetings of the 15<sup>th</sup>Academic Council

**Resolution No. AC/16/1:** The Council confirmed the minutes of the 15<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Academic Council held on 05<sup>th</sup>March, 2021.

2. Agenda Item no. 16/2: To confirm the amendments in Ph.D regulations.

Resolution No. AC/16/2: The Council members discussed each point and the following changes were suggested:

- 1. To mention that the new rules will be applicable from academic session 2021.
- 2. Temporary withdrawal of two semesters for any valid reason may be given to students pursuing Ph.D.
- 3. Point 1(K) to be included.
- 4. In para 2 B(4) to remove the word faculty
- 5. Para 3 A (i) to be rewritten as "In service personnel belonging to armed forces like State Police, Central Armed Police Force, Central Intelligence & Investigative Organization like CBI, IB, RAW and related domain.", and have put in min 5 years of service.
- 6. To be added in Para 3 A (iv) Professional candidates from Public Sector Undertaking (PSU), Research and Development Institute, Private Institutes and Private Industries of repute which are not recognized as Centres of Research by University may be admitted to PhD program with approval of Vice Chancellor provided he/ she has minimum five years of professional experience and is sponsored as part time candidate by the said organization and the DRC is convinced that he/she can pursue the entire PhD program effectively. The candidate must fulfill the minimum residential requirements for course work.
- 7. Para 5 (h): is to be read as follows: Selected candidates based on the above merit shall have to pay the prescribed fee within seven days from the date of offer of admission, failing which the seat shall be allotted to the next candidate in the said category of the merit list. Due intimation to be given to the candidates. (Employees working in Internal Security Agencies, Law Enforcement Agencies, Security

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Forces and in Criminal Justice, and other as mentioned in 3 A (i), (ii) & (iii) shall be given preference upto 50% of total seats).

- 8. To be added in Point 8.1 (c): "In special cases when expertise from professionals/ field experts is required and recommended by Departmental Research Committee (DRC) then the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor may appoint expert as deemed fit.
- 9. Para 25 & 26 will remain same as earlier.
- 3. Agenda Item no. 16/3:To confirm the syllabus of Bachelor of Arts (with Police Administration as one subject)
  Resolution No. AC/16/3: The Council approved the syllabus of Bachelor of Arts with Police Administration as one subject.

Agenda Item no. 16/6:To approve the remuneration for viva-voce examination of M.Tech dissertation to Rs.1000/- per students to external examiner Resolution No. AC/16/6: TheCouncil approved the remuneration for viva-voce examination of M.Tech dissertation to Rs.1000/- per students to external examiner with maximum payment of Rs. 5000/- per day.
- 7. Supplementary Agenda Item no. 16/1: To approve the admission cancellation/withdrawal or migration charges in view of COVID-19 as per guidelines of UGC dated July, 2021

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Resolution No.AC/16/SA/1: The council approved the guidelines of UGC dated July, 2021 and in view of COVID-19 (Pandemic) the following is considered "In view of the financial hardships being faced by parents due to lockdowns and related factors, a full refund of fees should be made on account of all cancellations of admissions/ migrations of students up to October, 31, 2021 for the academic session 2021-2022 as a special case. It is made clear that the entire fee, including all charges, should be refunded (i.e. there should be zero cancellation charges) on account of cancellations/ migration up to October 31, 2021. Thereafter, on cancellation/ withdrawal of admissions up to December 31, 2021, the entire fee collected from a student should be refunded in full after deducting not more than Rs.1000/- as processing fee".

- 8. Supplementary Agenda Item no. 16/2: To confirm the fees of the following PG Diploma/ Certificate Course:-

  - (ii) Certificate Course in Police Administration (Duration 06 months)
